Live Oak Estates Homeowners Association Rules for Member Statements During Board Meetings

Live Oak Estates board meetings are business meetings. The board has adopted the following rules for member statements during board meetings in accordance with Florida Statutes 720.303(2)(b) to ensure members have the opportunity to participate while maintaining a businesslike environment and respecting members' time. The board shall have the authority to enforce these rules.

- 1. Each member may make a statement regarding each agenda item prior to the board voting. All such statements must pertain to the current agenda item.
- 2. Each member may make a statement during the open forum portion of each meeting about any topic they choose.
- 3. Each member statement may last up to three minutes. The board may ask members to elaborate regarding their statement if needed and may extend the members time at its discretion.
- 4. Member statements must be businesslike. Profanity, shouting, ad hominem attacks, and other behaviors that interfere with the conduct of meetings are prohibited.
